Theme: Bringing Awareness and Prevention toward Substance Abuse

What/Why: Illegal drugs, legal drug overuse, opioids, under-age “vaping”, under-age alcohol consumption, alcohol overuse, under-age smoking, and many other forms of substance abuse can be bad for personal health and have additional negative life consequences. Substance misuse produces harmful health effects, family troubles, financial problems, community issues, and many additional concerns for our country. WE can all do our part towards awareness and prevention. This art contest is looking to raise awareness of this very serious substance abuse problem in our community and the country, as one of many steps towards prevention of Substance Abuse.

Who: Students in 6th, 7th, and 8th Grades

Details: Create a small poster that illustrates the dangers of, awareness towards, or prevention of Substance Abuse. Size - no larger than 11 inches by 17 inches, but smaller is good too! Artwork can be drawn, colored, painted, crayon, magic marker, pencil, etc. on the small poster paper. Works can be on regular sheet paper, loose leaf paper, poster board, cardboard, or any other flat paper - just keep it no bigger than 11in. x 17in. Nothing too graphic or inappropriate - check with your parents on that. Deadline for work and submission is 7 May 2019. All entries must have: name, gender, grade, and address/phone contact information written on back.

Submissions: Entries can be dropped in the St. Bede office entryway in the “Youth Art Contest” box. Submissions can also be coordinated by contacting Knight James Hubbard by e-mail at: hubby81@earthlink.net

Awards: \$25 Target gift cards will be awarded to one male and one female student from each of the 3 grade levels (6 total). Category winners will also receive award certificates.
