The worldwide organization of the Eucharistic Apostles of The Divine Mercy (EADM) ministry became an apostolate of the Marions of the Immaculate Conception of Stockbridge, MA in 1995. (<http://thedivinemercy.org/eadm/abouteadm.php>) EADM nurtures genuine belief in the Real Presence of Our Lord in the Most Holy Eucharist. The apostolate promotes Eucharistic Adoration, together with hourly praying of The Divine Mercy Chaplet for the sick and dying. EADM also provides many other works of mercy, including shipments of medical and educational materials to the poor worldwide, and prison ministries.

Specifically, the Saint Bede EADM ministry offers prayers, deeds of mercy, and the dissemination of information on Jesus' Divine Mercy, as well as an investiture of time and study of the Diary of Saint Faustina and Scripture in a monthly small group or cenacle that meets on the 4th Thursday of every month after Daily Mass. The ministry sponsored a live drama on Saint Faustina: Messenger of Mercy in 2014, sending the free will offering to Uganda. Saint John Paul II imparted a special Apostolic Blessing to all EADM members who support the exercise of this ministry, which involves Trust in Jesus, the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy, as well as a second Apostolic Blessing for praying the chaplet of mercy during Adoration for the sick and dying. All are welcome to learn more about the devotion of Jesus' Divine Mercy, which includes the Feast and Image Divine Mercy, and the Chaplet of Mercy.
